

How Do I Sign My Major/Minor in Broadcast & Cinematic Arts?



- **Tentatively decide which degree** you are seeking by consulting the following degree pages in the CMU Bulletin. B.A.A.; B.F.A; B.A.; B.S. in Ed; or B.S.
- Once you determine which degree you are considering, **check the BCA Advisors' list.** Advisor information is on all BCA bulletin boards and on the web at www.bca.cmich.edu. Advisors have posted office hours when they are available to answer your questions.
- **Get an unofficial copy of your transcript(s)** from the Registrars office (Warriner 212 or the Student Service Court at the University Center). This is particularly important if you are a transfer student. You must get copies of ALL transcripts. Bring the transcripts with you when you meet your advisor.
- **Meet with your advisor** to set up your file and prepare to sign your major. If the advisor's office hours conflict with your class schedule, you must make arrangements to meet at a mutually agreed upon time.
- **Take signed paperwork to Registrars' Office.**
